



KNOW THE ADVERTISING RULES

2018 CASTLEGAR AND DISTRICT REGIONAL FACILITIES, RECREATION, PARKS AND LEISURE SERVICES NON-ELECTION ASSENT VOTING ADVERTISING

Non-election assent voting advertising is any advertising during a non-election assent voting proceedings period that promotes or opposes, directly or indirectly, a particular outcome for the vote.

Non-election assent voting is taking place in the Regional District of Central Kootenay. If you advertise from May 24 to June 23, 2018, during the 2018 Castlegar and District Regional Facilities, Recreation, Parks and Leisure Services Non-election Assent Voting, you have rules to follow under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*:

- You must register with Elections BC as a non-election assent voting advertising sponsor **before** conducting any advertising.
- You must include your name and contact information on all advertising.
- You must file a disclosure statement with Elections BC by Friday, September 21, 2018.
