



KNOW THE ADVERTISING RULES

2017 LAKE COUNTRY BY-ELECTION THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING

Third party advertising is any election advertising not sponsored by a candidate or elector organization.

If you advertise as a third party from May 9 to June 24, 2017, in the 2017 Lake Country By-election, you have rules to follow under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*:

- You must register with Elections BC as a third party sponsor **before** conducting any advertising.
- You must include your name and contact information on all advertising.
- You must not sponsor advertising on behalf of, or together with, a candidate or elector organization.
- You must file a disclosure statement with Elections BC by Friday, September 22, 2017.

Media outlets **cannot** publish or transmit election advertising on General Voting Day, Saturday, June 24, 2017.
