

2023 LANGFORD-JUAN DE FUCA BY-ELECTION

The 2023 Langford-Juan de Fuca By-election is on Saturday, June 24, 2023. There are lots of ways to vote.

You can vote if you are:

- a resident of the Langford-Juan de Fuca electoral district,
- 18 or older on June 24, 2023,
- a Canadian citizen, **and**
- a resident of British Columbia since December 23, 2022



Voting in the district electoral office is available during office hours from now until 4 p.m. on Election Day.

Vote by mail



If you requested a vote-by-mail package from Elections BC, return it as soon as possible. Vote-by-mail packages must be received by Elections BC by 8 p.m. (Pacific time) on Saturday, June 24, 2023. Mail your completed package as soon as possible or drop it off at the Langford-Juan de Fuca district electoral office.

Ways to vote

Vote at advance voting – Find advance voting places and the dates they are open below, or visit wheretovote.elections.bc.ca/ljf.

Vote on Election Day – Find voting places and the dates they are open below, or visit wheretovote.elections.bc.ca/ljf. Election Day is Saturday, June 24, but there are lots of ways to vote before then.

What should I bring to vote in person?

- ID that shows your name and home address. See elections.bc.ca/id for the list of acceptable ID.
- Your Where to Vote card. Look for it in the mail from Elections BC. It will make voting faster and easier.
