

Notice to building owners and property managers:

Please be advised, under section 228.01 of the *Election Act*, authorized canvassers are entitled to access multiple residence buildings in their electoral district between the hours of 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. during the campaign period (from the day the writs are issued until General Voting Day). A canvasser may be a candidate or an individual authorized in writing by a candidate in order to canvass voters and distribute candidate information on the candidate's behalf.

At the request of a resident or individual acting on behalf of a multiple residence building, a canvasser entering a residential property must produce:

- government issued photo identification, and
- proof of candidacy or this authorization form
