- Enter the full name and contact information for the deputy financial agent. As a minimum, a mailing address and phone number must be provided. Please note that this form is available for public inspection.
- The declaration must be completed by the deputy financial agent. The deputy financial agent may accept referendum contributions and other income and file reports in accordance with the *Electoral Reform Referendum 2018 Act* and its regulations.

An individual is NOT eligible to be a deputy financial agent if the individual:

- is not 18 years or older as of July 1, 2018
- does not have full capacity to enter into contracts
- is not a Canadian citizen
- has not been a resident of British Columbia since January 1, 2018
- is, or intends to be, a candidate, or a financial agent for a candidate or elector organization, participating in the 2018 General Local Elections
- is a candidate, or a financial agent for a candidate, in an election under the *Election Act* during the referendum campaign period
- is a financial agent for a political party or constituency association registered under the *Election Act*
- is a Member of the Legislative Assembly
- is an election official, referendum official, voter registration official or employee of Elections BC
- is an undischarged bankrupt or was discharged from bankruptcy within the past 7 years
- has made a proposal under Part III of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada)* that was approved or deemed to be approved by the court, and in relation to which no certificate of full performance was issued or such a certificate was issued within the past 7 years
- has been convicted of an offence under the *Election Act*, the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, the *Recall and Initiative Act*, Division 18 [*Election Offences*] of Part 3 [*Electors and Elections*] of the *Local Government Act*, or a regulation under any of those Acts, within the past 7 years
- has been convicted within the past 7 years, in or out of British Columbia, of an offence involving fraud
- has had their designation as financial agent rescinded under the Electoral Reform Referendum 2018 Regulation
