



KNOW THE ADVERTISING RULES

2019 CARIBOO REGIONAL DISTRICT BY-ELECTION THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING

Third party advertising is any election advertising not sponsored by a candidate or elector organization.

If you advertise as a third party from March 2 to March 30, 2019 in the 2019 Cariboo Regional District By-election, you have rules to follow under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*. You must:

- Register with Elections BC **before** conducting any advertising
- Include your name and contact information on all advertising
- Not sponsor advertising on behalf of, or together with, a candidate or elector organization
- Not spend more than the expense limit
- File a disclosure statement with Elections BC by Friday, June 28, 2019
