



# KNOW THE ADVERTISING RULES

## 2018 QUEEN CHARLOTTE SEWER TREATMENT FACILITY NON-ELECTION ASSENT VOTING ADVERTISING

**Non-election assent voting advertising is any advertising during a non-election assent voting proceedings period that promotes or opposes, directly or indirectly, a particular outcome for the vote.**

Non-election assent voting is taking place in the Village of Queen Charlotte. If you advertise from January 25 to February 24, 2018, during the 2018 Queen Charlotte Sewer Treatment Facility Non-election Assent Voting, you have rules to follow under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*:

- You must register with Elections BC as a non-election assent voting advertising sponsor **before** conducting any advertising.
- You must include your name and contact information on all advertising.
- You must file a disclosure statement with Elections BC by May 25, 2018.
