DAY-TO-DAY ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF ELECTOR ORGANIZATIONS

The Local Elections Campaign Financing Expense Limit Regulation B.C. Reg. 309/2016 was amended on Friday, April 27, 2018. Day-to-day administrative expenses incurred from April 27, 2018 to October 20, 2018 of an elector organization that operates on a continuing basis are election expenses.

Since all election expenses must be paid exclusively from a campaign account, all day-to-day administrative expenses incurred from April 27, 2018 to October 20, 2018 inclusive, **must** now be paid from a campaign account. Such expenses include, but are not limited to, salaries and wages, office rent, utilities and insurance, accounting and legal services, office expenses and travel.

Elections BC is currently updating the elector organization forms and guides to reflect this change.
